1. Purpose: To promulgate Change 2 to Revision C of the Joint Fleet  
Maintenance Manual (JFMM).

2. Discussion:

a. Change 2 to Revision C adjudicated 228 change requests  
submitted by JFMM users, and is issued to clarify requirements,  
update procedures reflecting current practice, reduce redundancies to  
the instruction, and support the overall objectives of the JFMM.

b. Activities on distribution not requiring access to NNPI will  
receive enclosure (1).

c. Activities that require access to the NNPI contained in  
Volume V, Part II will receive enclosure (2). Enclosure (2) is NOFORN  
and contains NNPI information that must be safeguarded per NAVSEAINST  
C5511.32.

d. The JFMM is available on the World Wide Web at  
[www.submepp.navy.mil/jfmm/](http://www.submepp.navy.mil/jfmm/) and is distributed on CD-ROM to those  
activities authorized as indicated on the official distribution list,  
also available on the website.

e. Activities on distribution for the JFMM that require  
additional copies or activities wanting to be added to the  
distribution list should submit a letter to their applicable Type  
Commander (TYCOM), identifying the number of CD-ROM required along  
with justification for the request as identified in Volume I, Chapter  
1, paragraph 1.4 of the manual. Casual, informal and infrequent JFMM  
users will be referred to the web site identified in paragraph 2.d.

3. Action:

a. Replace Revision C Change 1 of COMUSFLTFORCOMINST 4790.3 with Revision C, Change 2 of COMUSFLTFORCOMINST 4790.3 in its entirety. Properly dispose the COMUSFLTFORCOMINST 4790.3 Revision C Change 1 CD-ROMs.

b. All activities shall conduct a detailed review of Revision C, Change 2 of COMUSFLTFORCOMINST 4790.3 using the Revision C Change 2 change synopsis located on the CD-ROM in accordance with paragraph 7.3.7.b of the Foreword section of the JFMM. Training shall be conducted for all personnel whose work assignments may require them to be familiar with the requirements of the JFMM. PowerPoint training files with an associated Word file highlighting the major changes are located on the CD-ROM.

4. Implementation:

a. TYCOMs shall establish an implementation date for Forces Afloat, subordinate units, and TYCOM-directed maintenance activities as soon as practical and promulgate via naval message.

b. As operators of the Regional Maintenance Centers and Naval Shipyards for the Fleet Commanders, CNRMC and NAVSEA 04 are requested to direct Naval Supervising Authorities to implement this change as soon as practical.

c. Ensure implementation direction does not create delay and disruption or unnecessary costs to the government for ongoing ship maintenance work.

d. Implementation direction is expected within 30 days of receipt of this letter. Request notification if implementation cannot be achieved within 60 days of providing direction and follow-on status, as necessary thereafter, until completely implemented.
